

## ***Using Remote Display Control to Project Your PocketPC***

### **Installing Remote Display Control**

1. Connect your PocketPC to your desktop with ActiveSync.
2. You can download this Microsoft program from <http://www.med.fsu.edu/informatics/Remotedsp.exe> or to save time, we have done this for you and created a folder on the All Users Drive called **Windows CE Stuff**. Use **My Computer** to open this folder. In it you will find a folder called **Remote Display Control**. Open it. In this folder is a file called **remotedsp.exe**. Drag and drop this to your computer's desktop, then double click it to run it. This will install Remote Display control to both your computer and to your PocketPC. Install it in main memory. It is small.

### **Running the Program**

3. Once it has installed, run the program on your computer:  
Start > Programs > Remote Display Control > Remote Display Control Host.
4. If the window looks small, under the Zoom menu, select 2X.
5. Now with your PDA still connected to your computer, run the program on your PDA.  
Start > Programs > cerdisp
6. Hit the Connect button.
7. When it asks for the hostname, make sure it says PPP\_PEER, and click OK.
8. The contents of your PDA will now show up on your desktop computer. You can use your mouse with that image to control the PDA or anything you do on the PDA will be displayed on your computer. If you now hook your computer up to a data projector, you can use this to teach a class. You can also use CTRL-ALT-Printscreen to capture images of the PDA screen which can be pasted into PowerPoints and Word documents.
