Dennis R. Mayeaux, M.D., of Milton was recently named the 63rd president of the Florida Academy of Family Physicians at its annual meeting in Boca Raton. The group is an association of family doctors with more than 4,000 members whose mission is to promote excellence in health care for Florida citizens. Dr. Mayeaux has been a member of the group for more than 30 years, serving on the board for more than 10 years, as vice-president from 2006-2008 and as the president-elect for the past year.

Dr. Mayeaux received an associate of arts degree from Pensacola Junior College, bachelor's degree from the University of Florida and attended the University of Miami College of Medicine. Dr. Mayeaux completed his family medicine residency at the Pensacola Educational Program. Dr. Mayeaux holds a clinical associate professorship at the Pensacola campus of the Florida State University College of Medicine, where he is also the family medicine clerkship director. Other professional appointments include executive director of the Santa Rosa County Medical Society and a previous position as chief of staff at Santa Rosa Medical Center. Dr. Mayeaux has also been in private practice for nearly 30 years with the Gulf Coast Physician Partners.

Dr. Mayeaux is an accomplished athlete and musician. He has completed 12 marathons, including the Boston Marathon twice, and has played the clarinet and tenor saxophone in a big band for more than 20 years. He also participates in medical volunteering for the Boy Scouts. He lives in Milton with his wife Janet and their three children.
