

The first is to provide health care to a profoundly under-served community.

The second is to provide the funds and guidance that will allow a first-generation US citizen, whose family is impoverished, the opportunity to achieve a lifelong passion of becoming a doctor.



By accepting the support from the Naples Lions Club Foundation, after earning the MD credential, the candidate will agree to serve a minimum of four years In an under-served community.



### **NLCF OBLIGATIONS:**

The Naples Lions Club Foundation will provide funds for tuition, room and board, books, fees, and living expenses for the candidate while in medical school.

Members of the Naples Lions Club Foundation will provide mentoring and support for the candidates through their educational journey.

- Desire to "give back" to the under-served.


### **CANDIDATE OBLIGATIONS:**

After earning the US granted MD degree, license, specialty training and board certification, the candidate will practice medicine for at least four years at a location in the world where people are markedly under-served in obtaining medical services. It is preferred that the graduate will pursue a career in primary care.

The location of the service is negotiable, for example, if a candidate is of Peruvian heritage and requests to serve in Peru, the NLCF will diligently attempt to comply with her/his request.
