

Faculty Mentor and Student Agreement Form – Summer Research Fellowship

The **Summer Research Fellowship (SRF)** program provides \$5,000 stipends to medical students conducting research between their first and second year of medical school, under the guidance of an **FSU faculty mentor**.

Goal: To foster research experiences that enhance students' scientific and clinical interests.

- **Program Timeline:** Mid-May to Mid-August 2025
- **Proposal Submission Deadline:** Tuesday, February 11, 2025, by 9:00 a.m.
- Requirements:
 - o Full-time summer research
 - o A summary/reflection paper must be submitted by early September 2025.
 - o Posters will be presented to a College of Medicine audience in mid-Fall 2025.

Key Notes:

- Students may join existing projects or create new ones.
- Non-FSU faculty are not eligible to serve as mentors.
- Only **one student per project** will be funded. Faculty may be a mentor for multiple students.
- Proposals must be student-written, though mentors may provide guidance.

Research Training Requirements

- **Human Subjects Research:** Complete CITI training (provided at no cost).
- **Animal/Wet Lab Research:** Training (e.g., animal handling, lab safety) must be completed <u>before research begins</u>.
