## **FSU professor to receive award for research on birth defects**

Gregg Stanwood, associate professor of biomedical sciences at the Florida State University College of Medicine, has been selected to receive the 2015 Patricia Rodier Mid-Career Award for Research and Mentoring. The award is presented by The Teratology Society for birth defects research, education and prevention.

The purpose of the award is to recognize a mid-career individual who has demonstrated successful independent research in neurobehavioral teratology, birth defects, or other related fields involving the central nervous system; and has demonstrated a commitment to mentorship of students, postdoctoral fellows, young investigators, and/or trainees.

Stanwood will receive the award and present his work, "Developmental Causes and Consequences of Drug Abuse," at The Teratology Society's 55th Annual Meeting in Montreal on June 28.
