North Florida Community College was awarded \$521,124 in grant money to go toward the North Florida Rural Health Workforce Development Network - and organization aimed at improving health care options and services in rural areas.

Founders of the Network include FSU's College of Medicine.

"Really trying to give these medical students a chance to see what it is these rural areas have to struggle with, what are some of their challenges, and really to give them a sense of what rural really means," said John Fogarty, Dean of FSU College of Medicine.

The grant will be disbursed over the course of three years. The network will host a summit on May 24th at NFCC to discuss training, retention, and recruitment in the rural medical fields.
