FSU's Pinto recognized for heart research

The Florida Heart Research Institute (FHRI) has named FSU College of Medicine professor Jose Pinto its Stop Heart Disease Researcher of the Year. Pinto, an assistant professor of biomedical sciences, was honored at the Florida Chapter of the American College of Cardiology annual meeting in Orlando. The award is given annually to the individual judged by the FHRI to be making the broadest impact on the advancement of knowledge in diagnosis and/or treatment of heart disease. The award includes a \$25,000 grant to be applied to future cardiac research in Florida.
