Josh Hayes, a 2005 graduate of Pedro Menendez High School, will graduate from the Florida State University College of Medicine Saturday in Tallahassee.

He was a member of the National Honor Society in high school and an accomplished member of the Menendez swim team, which advanced to the Florida finals during his junior and senior years.
