Medical school ranked seventh

FSU's College of Medicine has been ranked seventh in the country for Hispanics, according to *Hispanic Business* magazine, which has published its annual rankings of graduate schools in the magazine's September issue. The medical school was ranked 11th in 2008. The magazine based its ranking on a variety of factors, including the percentage of full-time Hispanic faculty, services for Hispanic students, Hispanic recruitment efforts and retention rates, the percentage of Hispanic students enrolled and the school's reputation as reflected in *U.S. News & World Report*.
