

Dear Friends:

On May 16, 2009, our school conferred the M.D. degree on the 73 members of our fifth graduating class. With five years of graduate data and the current matriculation of 120 students per year, we can look back at what we have accomplished with Dr. Michael Muszynski great pride. Our mission of encouraging primary care as a field

of choice, commitment to the health care needs of Florida, and educating future physicians of the highest caliber is being met by a wide margin. Our students are matching at some of the most prestigious residency programs in the country as can be seen in the 2009 Match results for our campus. However, an increasingly significant proportion of students are leaving our state for residency due to an alarming shortage of positions in Florida. Until that disparity is addressed by our legislators, we will not improve our physician workforce by adding more medical students. More than 60 percent of graduates practice in the state of their residency training and 30 percent at best return to their medical school state. On a brighter local note, there will be eight new FSU grad interns at Central Florida residencies and four of our previous graduates have been appointed Chief Residents at Orlando Health and Florida Hospital. All of these chiefs are from the Orlando Campus—something to be proud of indeed.


