Minimal Requirements	4-yr. BS/BA
Degree/Major:	Any major is acceptable as long as the student meets the minimal entrance requirements listed above.
Selection Factors:	Applicants are evaluated on the basis of their academic performance record, the MCAT/GRE, clinical experience, and personal interview.
Admission Test:	Most AA programs require applicants to take the Medical College Admission Test (MCAT) www.aamc.org/mcat or the Graduate Record Exam (GRE) <u>www.gre.org</u> . The MCAT exam fee is \$310. The GRE exam fee is \$205 and \$27 for each additional score report requested.
Application Services:	The central application service for AA programs is CASAA. Application are typically accepted between March and February of the following year. Applicants may also be required to complete a separate application for individual schools typically accepted between April and March of the following year. Check the individual school websites for specific application information. <u>https://casaa.liaisoncas.com</u>
Letters of Evaluation:	Most schools require up to three letters of recommendation including one from an anesthesiologist or an anesthesiologist assistant.
Experience:	All schools require familiarity with the field of medicine. A minimum of 8 hours of experience in an operating room environment observing the conduct of anesthesia is required. Additional hours are strongly recommended.
