Graduate Record Exam (GRE), clinical exposure/experience, extracurricular activities and a personal interview. A sustained record of high-level academic performance while carrying above average credit hour loads is expected for

competitive applicants

□ Volunteer Hours: Most programs recommend 40-50 hours of observation in several diverse OT

settings.

□ Admission Test: GRE

☐ Application Services: Occupational Therapy Centralized Application Service (OTCAS) will begin

accepting applications for most OT schools in June of the year before matriculation.
