

ECM 3-4 Interprofessional Teamwork 10/9-10/11, 2007
Faculty Prep Session

Module Objectives:

- 1) To raise awareness among medical students about the importance of teamwork in health care.
- 2) To increase knowledge in the essentials of teamwork.

The purpose of the faculty prep session is to prepare the small group facilitators for their role during the Plenary and Experiential Learning Stations.

- 1) Facilitators will be told briefly about the patient safety curriculum grant, its goals and objectives and how this module fits into the training program
- 2) Facilitators will be given a facilitator guide
- 3) Facilitators will be given a packet with student attendance and evaluation forms.
- 4) The leader of the session will ask facilitators to share experiences they have had while part of a team so that they can begin personal reflection with regard to teamwork
- 5) The plenary leader will discuss the flow of the plenary, goals and objectives of the training module.
- 6) There will be a discussion of how the learning stations will run and clarifications will be given for any facilitator that needs more information on their role during this session.
- 7) There will be a discussion regarding the purpose of the debriefing session and what take home messages they can leave with their small group to continue discussion in the future regarding teamwork.
